California Transportation Commission, Sacramento Area Council of Governments and Sacramento Metro Chamber Want Feedback on Transportation Issues

Public transportation forum being held in West Sacramento on June 24

SACRAMENTO, June 16, 2015 – The <u>California Transportation Commission</u> (CTC), Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) and Sacramento Metro Chamber want to hear from Sacramento Valley residents about how they view current highway and road conditions, and proposals to stabilize funding for transportation-system repairs and maintenance.

These organizations are hosting a public forum at the <u>West Sacramento City Hall Galleria</u>, <u>1110</u> <u>West Capitol Ave.</u>, <u>West Sacramento</u></u>, on Wednesday, June 24 from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. to discuss and generate feedback on those issues.

Topics to be covered at the forum include the local, regional and state role in funding road projects and maintenance; the impacts and reasons for California's and Sacramento Valley's deteriorating transportation system; and proposed short-term and longer-term solutions to stabilize road repair and maintenance funding.
